2020 State School Bond Californians for Safe Schools and Healthy Learning

Assembly Bill 48 (O'Donnell), the Public Preschool, K-12 & College Health & Safety Bond Act of 2020, places a \$15 billion state school facilities bond on the ballot for the March 3, 2020 Statewide Primary Election. In addition to K-12 (\$9 billion) and Community Colleges (\$2 billion), the bill includes California State Universities (\$2 billion) and University of California (\$2 billion). *Please pass a school board resolution on the need to continue to provide state matching funds for your school district.*

K-12 Programs Funded:

- New Construction at \$2.8 Billion
- Modernization at \$5.2 Billion
- Lead in Water Testing and Remediation \$150 Million (Out of Modernization)
- Career Technical Education at \$500 Million
- Charter Schools at \$500 Million

The bill also includes:

- Increased state matching amounts for low-wealth school districts
- Small School District Assistance
- Health and Safety Projects
- Disaster Assistance
- Financial Hardship Expansion
- Maintains the School Facility Program as an eligibility-based state matching program with assistance for districts needing additional help
- Key reforms to ensure school facilities funding is invested in districts that need it most.
- Preschool Facilities
